Note: Although the testers are listed under a specific city or County area they are certified to test throughout Orange County. A business license and/or plumbing permit may be required by the city in which the work is being conducted. Also, State law requires that anyone who contracts to do construction work be licensed by the Contractors State License Board in the license category in which the contractor is going to be working if the total price of the job is \$500.00 or more (including labor and materials). A State Contractors license is not required for the testing of backflow devices as long as the total cost is under \$500.00.
