A Message to Our Community

Recently there has been some media attention regarding the quality of tap water from suppliers across the nation. As a result, you may have concerns over the safety of your tap water. Mesa Consolidated Water District (Mesa) wants you to know that the water we provide to the community is of the highest quality and safe to drink.

The water Mesa provides meets or exceeds all stringent State and Federal drinking water regulations. Mesa takes seriously our responsibility to provide safe, high quality water to our customers. We frequently monitor to assure that our water meets the high standards of the Safe Drinking Water Act.

To ensure the integrity of the water Mesa performs numerous tests on its sources, treatment processes, and within the water delivery system. There are 26 in-line water quality analyzers located at 10 different sites that provide continuous results that are monitored remotely by Mesa staff. In 2008, more than 34,000 individual test results were garnered from samples collected by staff. Approximately 11,500 of these test results were conducted as required by drinking water regulations. The remaining 22,500 results were to ensure the water delivered met Mesa's high standards.

Every year, Mesa mails each customer a comprehensive water quality report that includes detailed information on water quality, including any violations of health protective standards under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

We are pleased to report that our utility met every single Federal and State standard last year and continues to meet those standards today. Our customers can be assured that in the event of contamination that poses an urgent risk to public health, we will immediately notify customers and advise them of how to protect themselves.
