



Construction Projects and Water Service Requirements

You must contact us if your project will need a new water service or if changes to existing water services will be needed.

You will need a new water service if one does not currently exist at the location.

You will need additional services or modifications to existing services if:

1. Your existing meter is too small or too large for the amount of water needed for your project.
2. You want to add or remove a service.
3. Fire or irrigation services will be modified or constructed as a part of your project.

If new or modified water services are needed there are certain procedures that Mesa requires you to follow:

1. An Application For New Service must be completed.
2. A Water Services Agreement must be signed by you and by Mesa.
3. Project plans must be submitted for Mesa's approval, along with a plumbing plan showing all external and internal water fixtures.
4. Payment of certain fees and charges which may include:
 - a. Plan check and inspection fee
 - b. Capacity charges
 - c. Meter installation fees
5. An acceptable Performance Guarantee Bond must be posted.

Mesa recognizes that the water purveyor has a responsibility to take all reasonable precautions to protect the integrity of the public water supply. Thus, in the exercise of this responsibility Mesa will need to conduct a cross connection control survey of your plumbing system. This letter does not address internal protection requirements. Mesa recommends that you contact the agency having jurisdiction to ensure your water system complies with plumbing codes.
