8. PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE PROPOSED COLLECTION OF CAPITAL CHARGES BY WAY OF THE OFFICE OF THE ORANGE COUNTY TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR:

President DePasquale announced the Public Hearing was now opened for the purpose of receiving comments regarding the proposed Collection of Capital Charges by Way of the Office of the Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector.

District Secretary Khalifa reported that a Notice of Public Hearing was posted at Mesa Water District's office and website on June 7, 2025 and June 26, 2025 and at Costa Mesa City Hall. Legal advertisements were published in the *Daily Pilot* on June 7, 2025 and June 14, 2025.

President DePasquale introduced Controller Phou who provided an overview of the topic.

President DePasquale opened the floor for public comments. There were no comments.

District Secretary Khalifa reported that the District had not received any written or verbal comments or letters of protest regarding the proposed Collection of Capital Charges by Way of the Office of the Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector.

Motion passed 5-0, by the following roll call vote:

9. RESERVOIRS 1 AND 2 PUMP STATION UPGRADES PROJECT:

Acting General Manager Wiesner provided an overview of the topic.

Motion by Director Atkinson, second by Vice President Dewane, to approve a contract to Black & Veatch Corporation for an amount not to exceed \$552,359 to provide Construction Management and Inspection Services for the Reservoirs 1 and 2 Pump Station Upgrades Project, and authorize execution of the contract. Motion passed 5-0.

10. PLAN CHECK CONSULTING SERVICES

Acting GM Wiesner provided an overview of the topic.

Mr. Wiesner responded to questions from the Board and they thanked him for the information.

MOTION

Motion by Vice President Dewane, second by Director Atkinson, to award a contract to John Robinson Consulting, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$180,000 per year for three years, with two 1-year renewable options, to provide Plan Check Consulting Services effective July 1, 2025, and authorize execution of the contract. Motion passed 5-0.

11. MESA WATER DISTRICT ANNUAL CUSTOMER SURVEY:

MOTION

Motion by Vice President Dewane, second by Director Bockmiller, to award a contract to FM3 Research for an amount not to exceed \$41,500 per year for three years, with two 1-year renewable options, to conduct the Mesa Water District Annual Customer Survey, and authorize execution of the contract. Motion passed 5-0.

12. LOCAL/REGIONAL WATER POLICY CONSULTING SERVICES:

Water Policy Manager Taylor provided an overview of the topic.

Ms. Taylor responded to questions from the Board and they thanked her for the information.

MOTION

Motion by Director Atkinson, second by Director Fisler, to approve a sole source contract to Ohlund Management & Technical Services to provide Local/Regional Water Policy Consulting Services for Fiscal Year 2026 through Fiscal Year 2030 for a total amount not to exceed \$200,000, and authorize execution of the contract. Motion passed 5-0.

13. REGULATORY CONSULTING SERVICES:

Water Policy Manager Taylor provided an overview of the topic.

Ms. Taylor responded to questions from the Board and they thanked her for the information.

MOTION

Motion by Vice President Dewane, second by Director Atkinson, to approve a sole source contract to Bolland & Associates to provide Regulatory Consulting Services for Fiscal Year 2026 through Fiscal Year 2030 for a total amount not to exceed \$75,000, and authorize execution of the contract. Motion passed 5-0.

14. GRANT WRITING AND ADMINISTRATION SUPPORT SERVICES:

Acting GM Wiesner provided an overview of the topic.

Acting GM Wiesner and Water Policy Manager Taylor responded to questions from the Board and they thanked them for the information.

Motion by Vice President Dewane, second by Director Fisler, to approve a contract amendment to West Yost for an amount not to exceed \$80,000 per year for five years for a total contract amendment amount not to exceed \$400,000 to provide Grant Writing and Administration Support Services, and authorize execution of the contract amendment. Motion passed 4-1, with Director Atkinson voting no.
