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Funding PFAS Treatment Systems for the Additional Wells

- 30 to 45 wells
- Assume \$5 mill per well
- \$150 to \$225 million
- Three additional Producers Buena Park, Newport Beach and Westminster
- Assume Producers keep wells operating except during construction period

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
