Site Preparation Work and Deliveries

Mesa Water District's construction of the SCADA Control Room and Wet Lab Upgrade at its Mesa Water Reliability Facility (MWRF) will resume in October. The new facility will allow Mesa Water staff to host educational programs and tours at the MWRF.

In preparation of the construction work, Mesa Water will install a temporary trailer at the MWRF from August 23-24, 2021.
