Pipeline Pre-construction to Start Survey and Utility Location Activity

As part of its Capital Improvement Program, Mesa Water District (Mesa Water®) is constructing two water wells and a pipeline within the City of Santa Ana. The project began in August 2020 with construction of the two wells. Pipeline pre-construction is starting with survey work and locating existing underground utilities.

The water well located at 4011 W. Chandler Avenue will be connected to the water well located at 3120 S. Croddy Way, by a 2,200-foot pipeline. An additional 2,300 feet of pipeline will connect the well on Croddy Way to Mesa Water's existing distribution system on Hyland Avenue and MacArthur Boulevard in Costa Mesa.

Pre-construction activities, including surveying and underground utility location, is expected to begin the week of August 16, 2021.



Project Activity During Construction

• Construction signs to notify residents, drivers, pedestrians and cyclists of construction activity and parking restrictions

Potential Impacts

• Temporary parking restrictions and street impacts during preconstruction activities
